Residency Format

Each cycle hosts one resident or a small cohort (2–3 practitioners) for up to 12 weeks.

During this time, residents engage with the QLO ecosystem through:

- Studio practice in shared workshop spaces
- Weekly dialogues and cross-disciplinary conversations
- Material and site exploration using local and circular materials
- Open studios or workshops with the QLO community

The residency values process and experimentation over finished outputs.

Who Can Apply

The program is open to:

- Artists and designers
- Architects and spatial practitioners
- Technologists and media makers
- Researchers and educators
- Craftspeople and interdisciplinary practitioners

Both individuals and small cohorts (up to three members) are welcome.

Prior experience with sustainability is not required; curiosity and openness to experimentation are essential.

What Residents Receive

Residents are supported with:

- Shared studio and workshop spaces
- Access to tools and materials
- Mentorship and dialogue within the QLO network
- Accommodation and meals on or around campus
- A stipend or production support depending on the residency cycle
